**1) Commercial Vendor Finance.**  
 The Licensee agrees, they have entered a contract and indebted to SPA the amount shown as the **“Total E.P.P. amount”** Of their chosen row as circled on Page 2/5. Full terms are on this page and [Pages 4 and 5 of C.T.D.](#) Any minor terms may be amended during training.

**2) Dates for payment.**  
 The EPP deposits and 1<sup>st</sup> EPP payment are due on the 1/5 & 2/5 dates. All payments are due the first day of each month thereafter, until total debt is paid in full.

**3) Payment received late, administration fee.**  
 If a payment is received late. a) A \$100 administration fee represents a standard reasonable cost of following up and accommodating any late payment. This late fee is added to the total debt, with 1% interest compounding per month also added to total debt.

**4) Acceleration of payments.**  
 If 2 defaults (full payments missed). Which may not be consecutive. The total balance of all sums are to be paid without notice and become immediately due and owing and be immediately recoverable as a debt.

b) If above event occurs the Licensee/s shall not be entitled to any discounts as otherwise offered.

**5) Costs of Default.**  
 Licensee/s shall pay all Spray Pave’s Court; Legal services; Investigation; and Recovery costs caused by their default under agreement on a full indemnity basis.

**6) Variation of E.P.P. agreed payment schedule or fees.**  
 If Licensee/s forwards a variation of agreed payments:- a) Payment date other than 1<sup>st</sup> of each month; b) Extra or reduced amount; c) More payments per month; (ie weekly or fortnightly). Licensee/s also accepts an extra administration fee of \$25.00 per variation of agreed set payments, to accommodate the extra administration. The \$25.00 is added to total debt with 1% compounding interest p/mt as per 3) Any variation will not affect any other clause or the entirety of this agreement. A full payout of total E.P.P. debt, does not attract extra fee.

**7) Signatory(ies) offers full personal guarantee** for Company, Trust or any other entity application.

**8) Joint and several liability.**  
 Where the Licensee constitutes more than one person. Each person will be jointly and severally liable for all total amounts under this agreement.

**9) Charge to SPA or Assignee. (SPA-or-A)**  
 If 2 defaults (full payments missed). Which may not be consecutive, Licensee/s charges in favour to SPA-or-A, their present and or future property. The property whether real or personal, including property described in the E.P.P. application, or any other property, shall be included into any other rights under this agreement. Licensee/s agree that SPA-or-A is entitled to lodge a caveat against any property registered in the name of the Licensee/s to protect SPA-or-A’s interest.

**10) Representation.**

**11) Legal and financial advice.**

**12) Severance**  
 If any provision in this agreement or any other documents be or become invalid, illegal or unenforceable, that provision shall be severed from said document, without effect to remaining provisions.

**13) Assignment by Licensee/s.**  
 The Licensee/s rights of this agreement may be assigned to another similarly secure party after a new EPP application is sent to SPA, which shall not be unreasonably denied.

**14) E.P.P. Management and Assignment.**  
 SPA outsource all E.P.P. account receivable management. In case of default as per 4) & 9). Licensee/s agrees that SPA will assign the total remaining balance amount of principal, interest and fees, under this agreement as a debt for collection to [AAA Mercantile](#) or any similar firm.

**15) Dispute resolution.**

**16) Exclusive Jurisdiction to South Australia. (SA)**  
 Both parties freely submit themselves to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of (SA) and the exclusion of any other state or territory courts. In respect of disputes whether under the contract or in respect of the contract. Any actions arising shall be instituted, heard and determined only in a court of Adelaide, South Australia.
